improvement program information from john wayne airport



Change Is
In The Air...
And On
the Ground

Construction is well underway on the John Wayne Airport (JWA) Improvement Program, and exciting new changes are becoming more visible to passengers and visitors to the Airport.

Construction of the new security gate on Campus Drive at Dove Street is nearly complete, providing a safe and secure entrance for General Aviation patrons on the South side of the airfield. A new state-of-the-art aircraft hangar, as seen in the photo below, is currently under construction in the same area, and will provide additional aircraft storage space for general aviation users and businesses.

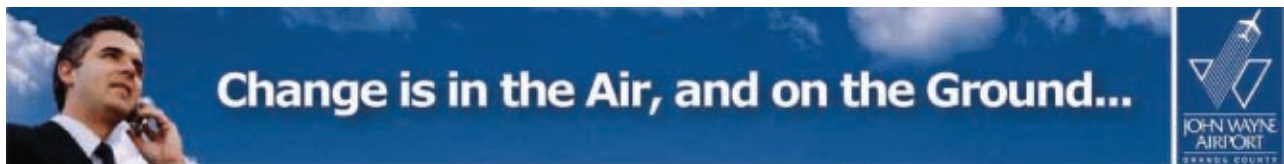
This fall, Parking Structure B1 will be removed to make room for the new passenger terminal. A new aircraft overnight parking area will become Parking Lot C, providing passenger vehicle parking until a replacement parking structure is built. Free shuttle service will provide transportation between Parking Lot C and Terminals A and B.

Parking Lot C will be located on Airport Way, north of Campus Drive and south of Terminals A and B and is scheduled to open August 1, 2008.



When Parking Structure B1 closes shortly after Labor Day, fewer parking spaces than normal will be available at the Airport. Passengers are encouraged to plan ahead and allow more time to find parking. Log on to www.ocair.com for more information about transportation options.

Recent Accomplishments:

The Board of Supervisors:

- Awarded a contract to Excel Paving for Construction of the temporary Parking Lot C;
- Authorized the Airport to Advertise for Bids for Design and Construction of 20 new commercial passenger loading bridges for Terminals A, B and C;
- Received bids and awarded a contract to Nuprecon, LP for Deconstruction of Parking Structure B1;
- Authorized the Airport to Issue a Request for Qualifications for Terminal C Construction.

Construction Progress:

- New hangar has been delivered and will be constructed in the area of the Dove St. gate;
- Excel Paving has completed the paving and constructed new entrance/exit lanes for Parking Lot C (scheduled to open August 1);
- The new security guard shack and fence at Dove St. are nearly completed and operational;
- Addition of a new left turn lane from Airport Way onto the airfield was completed specifically for construction access for Parking Lot C.

Looking Ahead:

Staff will recommend the Board of Supervisors:

- Award a contract to Heery International as Commissioning Agent for Terminal C.

Construction Status:

- Parking Lot C will open to the Public August 1;
- Parking Structure B1 will close permanently September 3.

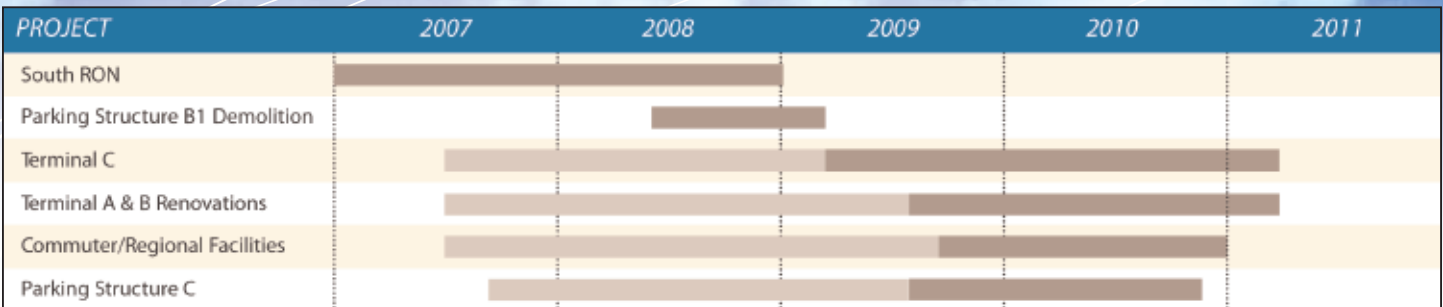
Amendments to the "Settlement Agreement" – the regulatory framework that governs operations at JWA – allowed the County to increase passenger capacity at JWA and to build the new facilities necessary to accommodate additional passengers, while maintaining an environmentally sensitive operation.

The Airport Improvement Program includes construction of a new multi-level terminal building with six new commercial passenger gates, six new security checkpoints, greater baggage screening capability, 2,000+ new parking spaces, and new commuter facilities at the north and south ends of the extended terminal.

With the major policy, environmental and financial foundation in place, JWA is moving forward with the Airport Improvement Program and is committed to providing those who live in and visit Orange County with safe, efficient, and attractive airport facilities. ▼
