## John Wayne Airport Student Art Contest Rules:

1. Only Orange County public and private school students in grades K-12 may submit artwork for this contest.
2. One original artwork submission per student. **NOT PERMITTED:** No use of copy-righted material, digital artwork or three dimensional work.
3. Artwork must be completed on a single sheet of 11" x 17" paper. NO EXCEPTIONS. Artwork MUST NOT be framed, mounted or outlined with any type of border; No collaborations permitted; DO NOT FOLD OR ROLL ARTWORK.
4. Artwork may be crayon, watercolor, acrylic or oil paint, color pencil, indelible marker pen, felt-tip pen, soft ballpoint pen or any similar indelible medium. **NOT PERMITTED:** Digital art, pencil, charcoal, oil crayon, chalk, glitter or collage work involving the use of photocopies.
5. Please print clearly and complete all information requested on entry form. **Contest entry forms with illegible printing and empty information fields will be disqualified.**
6. Entry form must be signed by parent, guardian or teacher confirming they understand the contest rules and the artwork submitted for entry is an original piece from that student.
7. Securely tape all four corners of the completed entry form to back of artwork.

A panel of judges will select first, second, third and honorable mention winners for each grade level of qualified entries received. In addition, one grand prize winner will be announced for each category: Category I, Grades K-6 and Category II, Grades 7-12.

All winners will be notified and invited by mail to attend an awards and recognition ceremony held in their honor on Sunday, December 8, 2019. Their artwork will be exhibited on the Arrival (lower) Level of the Thomas F. Riley Terminal from November 23, 2019 to January 16, 2020 and will be published on ocair.com for the year and promoted on all media including digital, electronic and print. Student's first name, first initial of last name, grade and school will be publicly listed (information may be excluded upon request).
